MED-B/Educational Sessions (Room J2)

On behalf of the Working Parties, clinicians will be presenting on specific diseases and graft types to help with completion of the data collection forms.

A new session "MED-A form" has been introduced to our programme. Virginie Chesnel from the EBMT Data Office will be presenting MED-A: standard and new items, DLI and the cell therapy form. She will also cover the EBMT data management organisation, data flow and working groups.

Participants will learn how to check and modify data directly from the report output, and how to transfer the output to other applications, such as MS Excel. We hope you will enjoy this new style course and look forward to receiving your feedback after the congress.

ProMISe Open Learning Centre (Room R9)

The ProMISe Open Learning Centre will be open on Monday and Tuesday for delegates to drop in and ask questions on data entry/retrieval using the Registry database. Support will be available in various European languages for all users. The room will be staffed by colleagues in the EBMT coordination offices and volunteers from National Registries / local centres who are experienced in using the Registry database.
