ProMISe 2 Launch

We would like to remind all current users that ProMISe 2 will go into production from June 2004

The transition to ProMISe 2 will happen gradually throughout the Summer of 2004.

The EBMT registries and some national registries (Austria, Switzerland, Czech Republic) will be the first to switch. Other national registries and EBMT centres will follow.

The French national registry (SFGM) has agreed to begin using ProMISe from December 2004.

We will keep you updated with instructions and information during the transition period.

Current users do not need to re-apply to use ProMISe 2, as all existing usernames and passwords will automatically be transferred to the new system.

ProMISe 2 Demo now online

The demo version is available on the server. There is nothing to download, you only have to access it online. Once you are sure your PC meets the requirements below, click on this link to access the [ProMISe demo](#).

Select [Demo Session] from the list of session types, then click on [START SESSION]. A username and password will be entered for you automatically.

(The default session in the Demo is MED-A only). For further instructions please see 'Documentation' →

Reminder: system requirements

Recommended for centres:

Operating System: WIN 2000/XP (pref); WinNT; Win98

Memory: 512Mb (or 256MB for MED-A only)

Processor: 1Ghz (or 500 Mhz for MED-A only)

Monitor/graphics card: 17inch monitor; graphics card absolute minimum 1024*768; 1280*1024 recommended
