ACHIEVEMENTS 2024

EAST EUROPE NURSES GROUPS:

- Evaluate needs together with Nurse leaders from:
 - > Slovenia

Together we coordinate and provide a range of educational activities for nurses and allied health professionals within the field of Haematopoietic Stem Cell Transplantation and Cell Therapy



Organize and coordinate HSCT and Cell Therapy nursing educational events and activities in LMICs. Work in collaboration with like-minded entities to foster and strengthen the ability of local nurse leaders to develop and sustain educational networks.

Create models (educational, training, networking groups) that may become part of the global HSCT and cell therapy community.

ACHIEVEMENTS 2024

 - > Recently endorsed as a formal group within the Czech Republic Society of Haematology.

 - > Czech Republic Nurses Group joins the eleven existing National Groups EBMT Nurses Group.

Nurses navigating the EBMT website

□ NURSE NAVIGATION EBMT WEBSITE PROJECT:

The results of the survey delivered to better understand and improve the website experience of nurses was submitted for the annual meeting. We describe a summarize of the study:

\succ AIMS:

- Understand how nurses use the EBMT website, find information and navigate their way to access our resources.
- > Identify possible barriers in navigating the website and help us identify areas where access and navigation need to be improved

METHODS:

- Survey created and sent on a first round in October and closed in December 2023.
- Second round: opened February and closed in April 2024.

RESULTS:

- First round 124 nurses from 33 different countries in Europe, Asia, Latin America and Africa responded.
- Second round: 227 evaluable responses

- \blacktriangleright Advances of the proposal: Development of a navigation guide. Aims:
 - \succ Enable the EBMT community to benefit from the range of available educational resources.
 - \blacktriangleright Involve National Nurses Group linked to EBMT Nurses Group with translation and sharing information.

East Europe Nurses Groups

Support creation of the Balkan Nurses Group (Croatia and Slovenia)

South Africa Project 2025:

- Collaboration EBMT NG Board, GEC NG and South African Nurses.
- > Monthly meetings (from January 2025, two meetings have been held currently).
- > The BloodSA HSCT Nurses Working party has been established and recognized within the BloodSA Foundation. Actions:
 - Development of Terms of Reference
 - Setting up the Nurses Working Party Board with 2 Chairs and 2 vice-chairs.

\succ CONCLUSIONS:

- Responders reported a positive EBMT website experience and were able to find the desired information.
- \blacktriangleright Most of the nurses that responded had more than 15 years' experience
- > Most of the countries one response... so probably we haven't reached our main target: RN working on the wards and young nurses.
- It is important to pay attention to those reporting difficulties since barriers such as language and unclear navigation likely deter further visits and recommendations of the website to other nurses.
- > We propose that the development of navigation and addition of translation tools may well address these challenges and enable more nurses in the EBMT community to access the range of available educational resources.

Next collaboration: Educational training via online platform through BMT Classroom. \blacktriangleright Working on the program.
